FACTS	WHAT DOES MAVEN CAPITAL PARTNERS, LLC (“MAVEN CAPITAL”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
WHAT?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social security number and assets • Name, address, telephone number • Income, risk tolerance, and previous investment experience • Educational/employment information <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share information about you as described in this notice.</p>
HOW?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons Maven Capital chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Maven Capital protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Maven Capital collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete an investment advisory contract or other forms • Open an account or seek financial advice about your investments • Give us your contact information • Give us your employment history • Communicate with Maven Capital via telephone, mail, or e-mail
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for a partnership interest I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices apply to all parties, unless you inform Maven Capital otherwise in writing.

Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our affiliates include companies with common control such: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Maven Capital Advisors, LLC, MCA Securities, LLC, Maven Employment, LLC, Reicon Wealth Advisors, LLC, RWA Capital, LLC, Reicon Capital, LLC, Reicon Investment Advisors and Reicon Management.
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maven Capital does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maven Capital does not currently have non-affiliated joint marketing partners.
